All school books and core classroom resources will be provided by the school for incoming First Years. Please see Page 3 for additional information.

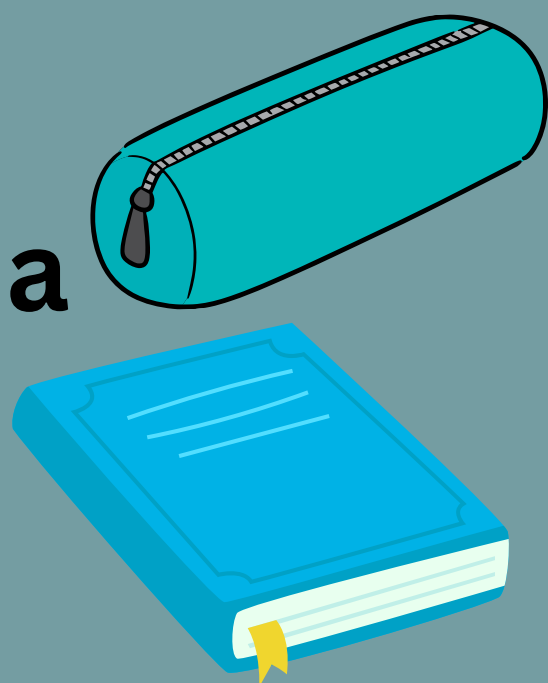

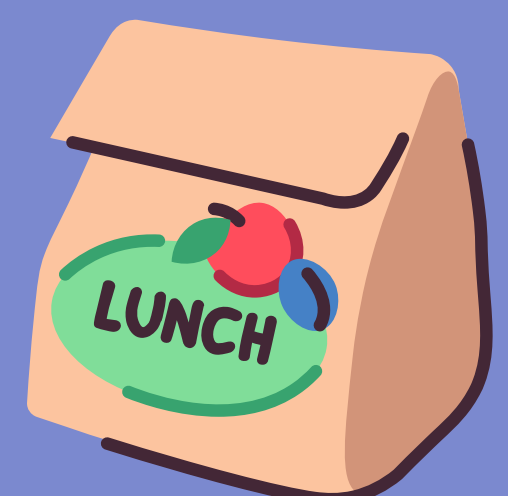

# School Book Scheme



Please note under the Schoolbooks Scheme in Post Primary School, all Junior Cycle Textbooks & core classroom resources will be provided for incoming students.

Parents/guardians will be required to provide the following;

- Pens/pencils
- Colouring pencils
- Ruler/rubber/sharpener
  - Pritt stick
  - Mathematical Set
- Whiteboard & Whiteboard Markers

Under the Schoolbooks Scheme, The following core classroom resources will be provided to all incoming students:

- 1 school journal per student per Junior Cycle year
- 12 copybooks (incl. equivalent hard back copybook or refill pad) per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 display A4 plastic folder per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 plastic zip A4 folder/carry case per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 set of ledgers/journals/cash books required for accounting/business studies per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 science copybook per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 music copybook/manuscript per student per Junior Cycle year
- 1 set of grammar books per student (to remain assigned to that student for the duration/remainder of the Junior Cycle)
- 1 maths formulae & tables/log book (to remain assigned to that student for the duration/remainder of the Junior Cycle)
- 1 scientific calculator (to remain assigned to that student for the duration/remainder of the Junior Cycle)
- Dictionary/(ies) (to remain assigned to that student for the duration/remainder of the Junior Cycle)

# Key Reminders -Attendance

- **Absent from school** ; If your child will be absent, please email the school office at info@johnthebaptistcs.ie stating a reason before 8.50am.
- **Multiple-day absences** - Please include all relevant dates in your email and reason for absence.
- **Late Arrival-**
  - Student must present to relevant Deputy Principal office
  - Journal must be stamped to allow access to class.
  - A text will be sent to parents to notify of late attendance.
  - Repeat offences may result in lunchtime reflection and/or further interventions.
- **Early collection (e.g. appointment)**
  - Notify school via email before 8.50 of time of collection & reason for same.
  - The student must sign out at the main reception.
  - A parent must collect the student from main reception.
  - Where possible please book appointments for outside of school hours.
- **Student Unwell** - For their health, safety & wellbeing, students must come to the sick bay if they feel unwell and home will be contacted if deemed necessary.
- **Contacting Home** - Students are **not permitted** to use their personal phones to contact home. They must go to a member of management, reception or sick bay.

# School Rules

All students are expected to take responsibility for their learning and behave in a manner that is respectful and which ensures that our school is a safe and secure place for all.

	Expectation	Consequence
Coat	Coats must be black or navy and clearly labelled. Coats may not be worn in the classroom.	You will be asked to remove your coat. If you refuse or must be asked repeatedly, you will be asked to bring your coat to the Deputy Principal or Principal – it may be collected at the end of the day.
Mobile Phone	You must not have your mobile phone on your person. It must be switched off and in your locker/bag.	Your phone will be confiscated and given to the Deputy Principal or Principal – it may be collected at the end of the day. Refusal to comply and/or repeat offences may result in the phone being kept for longer.
Jewellery	No more than one small stud earring on each earlobe may be worn. No other jewellery is allowed.	Items of jewellery which are not permitted will be confiscated- they can be collected at the end of term. Refusal to comply and repeat offences will result in lunchtime reflection.
Ties	You must wear your school tie at all times.	If you do not have your tie, you will be given a warning. Repeat offence will result in a de-merit. You can borrow a school tie from the Deputy Principal or Principal's office – you will be asked to hand over your phone in exchange.
Nails	Gel-nails, Shellac, nail extensions etc. are not allowed.	You will be asked to remove the nails. Refusal to comply and repeat offences may result in you being asked to stay at home until nails are removed.
Hair	Hair must be kept back off your face – tied back or tied up.  No scratches/cut-ins allowed.	You will be asked to tie back your hair – hair ties are available from the Deputy Principal and Principal offices. Repeat offences may result in a de-merit and/or lunchtime reflection.  You will be given a demerit and asked to have scratch/cut-in removed. Repeat offences may result in lunchtime reflection and/or being sent home.
Make-up	Make-up is not allowed. This includes false eyelashes and fake tan.	You will be given a demerit. Repeat offences will result in lunchtime reflection and/or being sent home.
Fizzy / Energy drinks	You must not bring fizzy/Energy drinks to school.	A teacher will dispose of the drink and return the bottle so that you can refill with water.

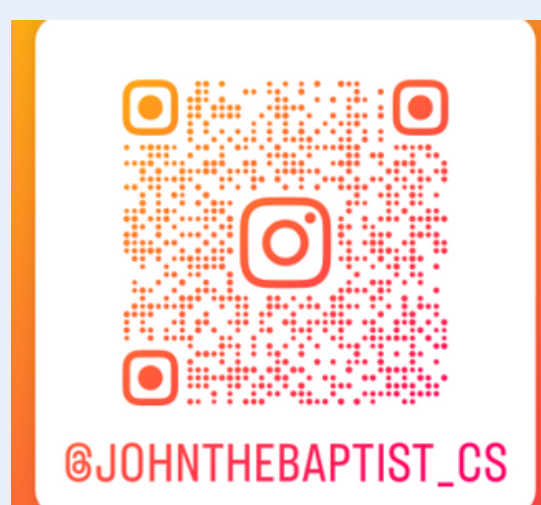

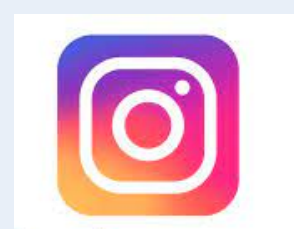
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
